REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MINOR IN ECONOMICS**

Minors in economics must take at least six (6) units in economics including Economics 100, 200, 251 and 252. Accounting 203 & 204 and Economics 108 & 115 do *not* count towards the minor in economics. Courses taken at other universities or as part of off-campus study programs do not count towards the major unless they are approved by the department.

Minors may substitute an additional economics elective for Economics 200 if they take any of the following: Mathematics 113, 213, 325, 326 or Psychology 205.

Economics minors must maintain a university grade point average of at least 2.0 and an economics grade point average of at least 2.0. Students will not be admitted to the minor unless they have at least a 2.0 university cumulative average and at least a 2.0 cumulative average in economics.
