**Alumni:** Approximately 31,100 as of October 2008. The St. Lawrence Alumni Association, founded in 1877, represents the alumni body at large. Representatives of class groups are named each year to a governing body – the Executive Council. The Alumni Association assists in admissions, fundraising, career counseling, public relations and recognition of alumni for their service to the University and their communities.

**Graduation Rates:** The following is the percentage of students who graduated within five years of matriculating:

**Outcomes:** For the Class of 2007 (the most recent class for which figures are available), of the 63% of the class who provided information, 97% are in full-time employment (77%) or graduate and professional schools (20%).

**Library Facilities:** Owen D. Young Library and Lauenders Science Library: seating for over 900; over 1.6 million books, government documents, videos, microforms, print and electronic journals over the campus network; several special collections.

**Computer Facilities:** 259 computers in public access computer labs across campus; 99 readily scheduled teaching and learning spaces equipped with academic and presentation technologies; widely available wired networking and Internet access; secure wireless networking in all University-owned student residences, along with the Student Center, both libraries, Johnson Hall of Science and other buildings. Networked laser printing in most labs. All residential computer labs are open 24 hours; most classroom computer labs are open 8:00 a.m.-11:00 p.m. Lab computers run Microsoft Windows Vista with Office 2007; Macintosh computers run Tiger and with Office 2008. Campus-wide cable television system, providing 12 University channels and basic cable to every room on campus, free of charge; students may subscribe to digital cable to receive premium channels, DVR capabilities and Pay-Per-View programming.

**Residences:** 12 residence halls for students; five Greek houses; several theme cottages and intentional living communities.

**Athletic Facilities:** Indoor facilities include two field houses, each with artificial turf infield, track and tennis courts; two regulation basketball courts; competition swimming and diving pool; 10-court squash center; 133-station fitness center; climbing wall; ice arena; equestrian arena. Outdoor facilities include competition and practice fields for soccer, softball, baseball, football, lacrosse and field hockey along with a lighted artificial turf field; six lighted tennis courts; lighted all-weather nine-lane track and lighted football/track stadium; 18-hole championship golf course. Recreation facilities include jogging/walking trail, cross country/mountain bike trails, intramural fields, outdoor basketball and volleyball courts. Varsity teams number 32 (15 men's, 16 women's and one coeducational). Men's and women's ice hockey are NCAA Division I; the remainder are Division III, with the exception of equestrian, which is not an NCAA sport at the Division III level. Intramural and club teams flourish in several sports and activities, depending on student interest.
