

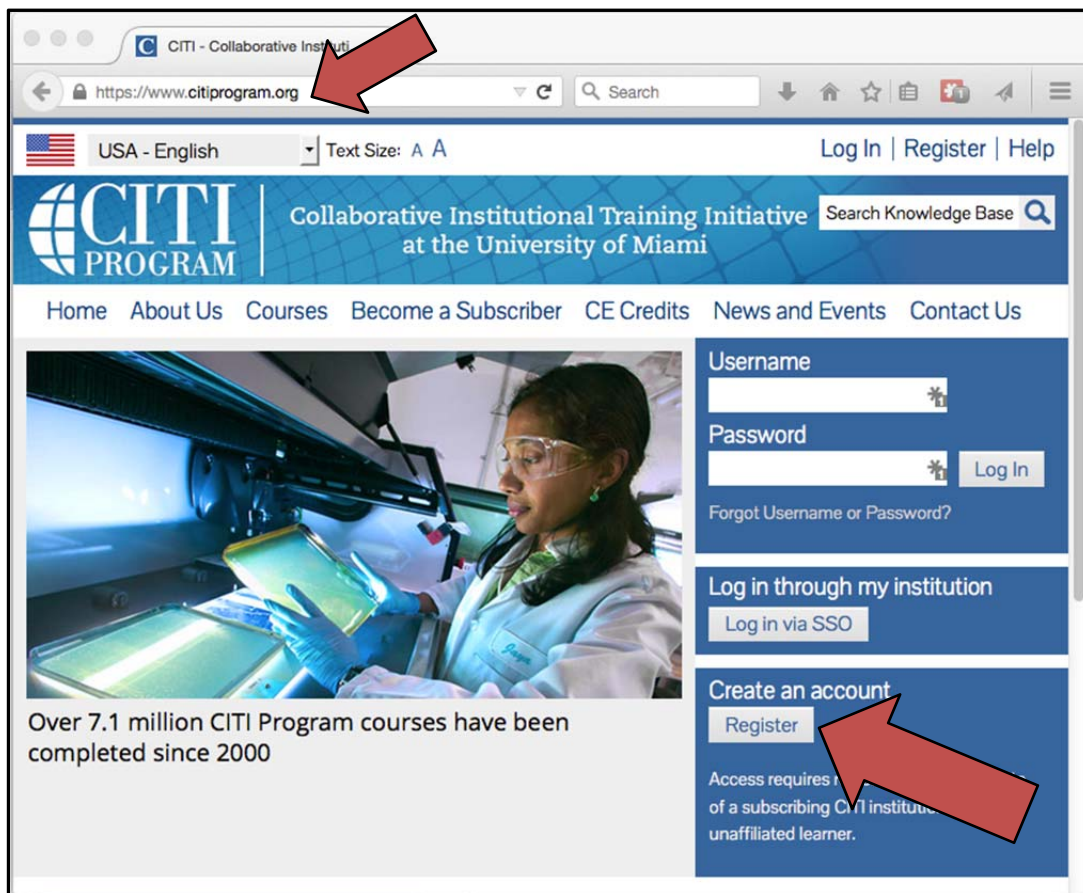
ITI PROGRAM: RESPONSIBLE CONDUCT OF RESEARCH (RCR) TRAINING: INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENT RESEARCHERS

These instructions provide information on the following:

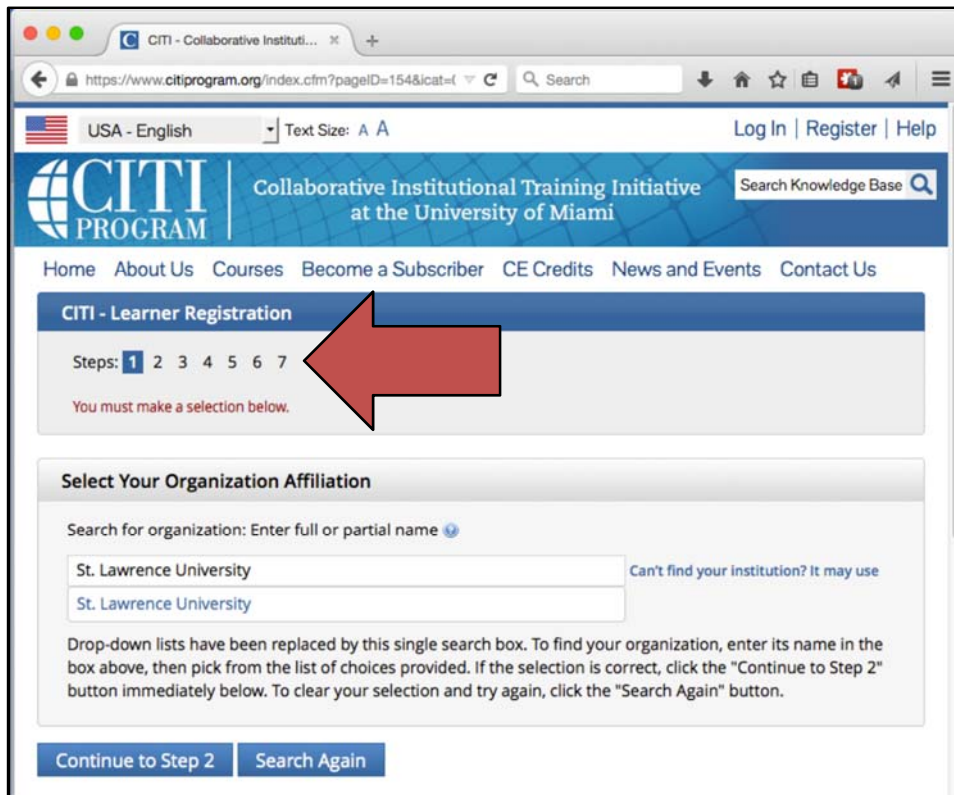

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1. CREATING A CITI PROGRAM ACCOUNT:

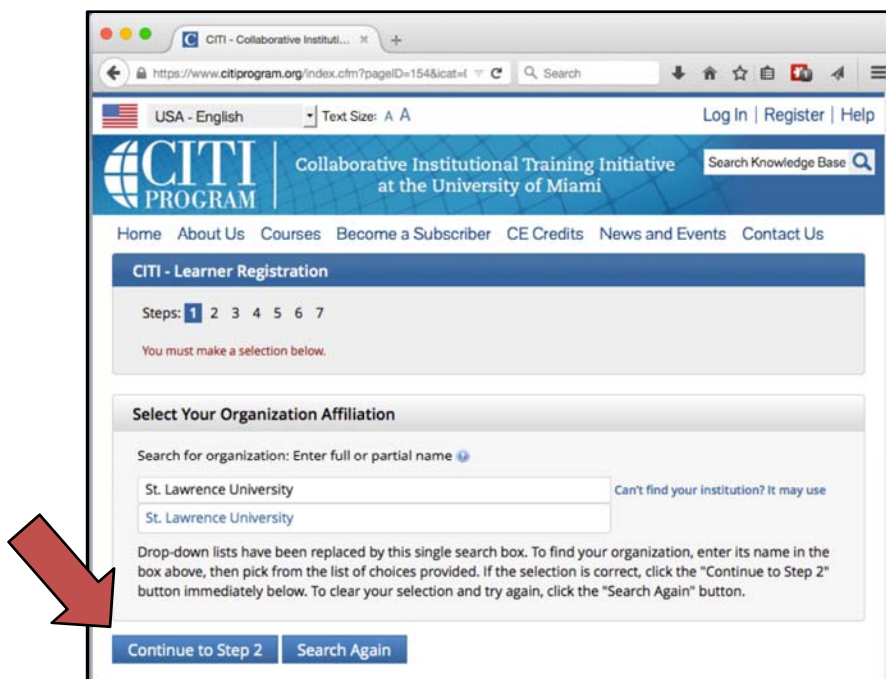
- Open a web browser and navigate to <https://citiprogram.org>
- Click *Register* under *Create an Account*



- Follow the **7 steps** in the registration process



- **Step 1:** Under Select Your Organization Affiliation, search for and select “St Lawrence University”; click ***Continue to Step 2***



Follow the instructions provided to complete the other steps.

Here is some additional information for completing those steps:

- **Step 2:** Note that a second email is not required

- **Step 5:**
 - Indicate that you opt NOT to receive credit
 - It is up to you whether you allow CITI Program to contact you regarding participation in research surveys

- **Step 6:**
 - An Employee Number is not required; leave that blank
 - “Role in Research”:
 - Choose ***Student Researcher – Undergraduate***

- **Step 7:** Choose the following options for each section:
 - **Question 1: Human Subjects Research**
 - Choose ***Not at this time***
 - Select this option even if you do research with humans; training in this area is handled separately by the IRB

 - **Question 2: Responsible Conduct of Research**
 - Choose ***NSF Student Researchers (RCR)***

 - **Question 3: Laboratory Animal Research**
 - Choose the last option: ***Not at this time, thank you***
 - Select this option even if you do research with animals; training in this area is handled separately by the IACUC

 - Q4: Institutional/Signatory Officials
 - Choose ***Not at this time***


 - Click ***Complete Registration***

- Click ***Finalize Registration***



2. COMPLETING COURSES

- Click on *St. Lawrence University Courses* to display your available courses and progress
- Click the course title to begin. The course to complete is NSF Student Researchers (RCR)
- Before beginning a course and when you return to a course, you must complete the *Integrity Assurance Statement*.

PLEASE NOTE:


- You are required to complete the NSF Student Researchers (RCR) course (all 9 modules) in CITI as part of the RCR training requirement.

Some Additional Helpful Information about Completing Courses:

- You do not need to complete all of the modules in one sitting.
- You cannot begin a module until you have completed the previous module.
- After each module, you will complete a quiz. You must achieve an average overall score of 80% on the quizzes to be certified as completing the training.
- You should complete the modules as soon as possible and no later than within the semester or summer that you begin work on NSF-funded research.

3. NAVIGATING THE CITI PROGRAM SITE:

- Click *Main Menu* to display your available courses
- Click *My Reports* to track your completion record

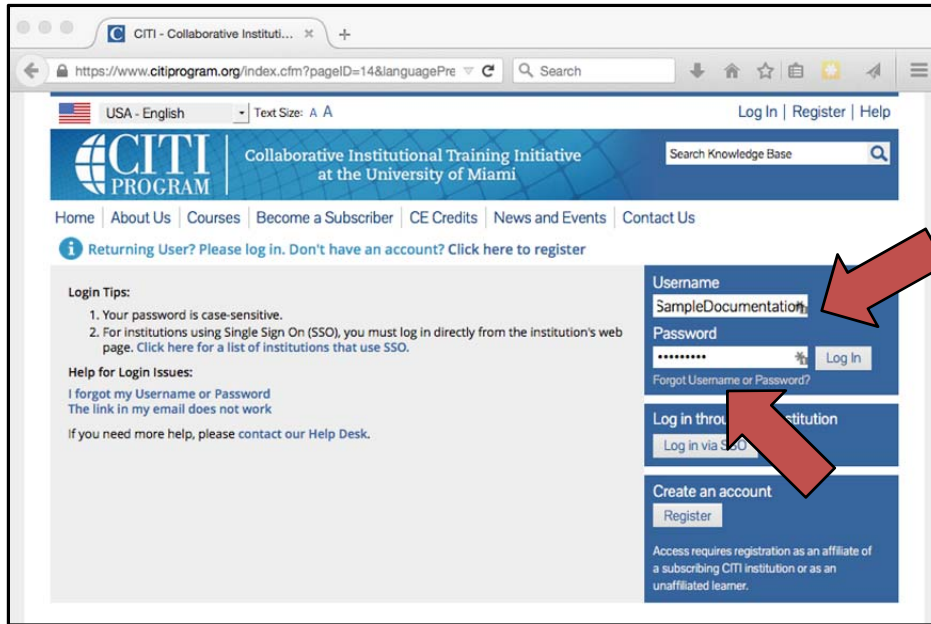

4. RETURNING TO THE CITI PROGRAM SITE:

- Open a web browser and navigate to <https://citiprogram.org>
- Enter your Username and Password
- If you have forgotten your login information, click the link to retrieve that information via email



5. DOCUMENTING COURSE COMPLETION AND CERTIFICATION OF RCR TRAINING COMPLETION

- Inform the faculty PI supervising the research when you have completed the CITI course.
- You should print Completion Reports for your records.
- Completion of the Post-course evaluation is voluntary.
